The Role of Regional, National, Institutional & EU Funding in the Long-Term Sustainability of Research Infrastructures

Hamburg, 1-2nd March 2018

The complex interplay of regional, national, institutional and EU funding should not become an obstacle in the development of research infrastructures. With this in mind, the goal of this workshop is to bring together **stakeholders** from different **research facilities** and **public funding organisations** to:

- **identify** the main **bottlenecks** during the different RI phases
- **discuss** the importance of the **national roadmap process**, its **timing** and **funding**
- **share experiences** with regard to the long-term funding of RIs
- provide **recommendations** for a better **coordination** of the different levels of **RI funding**

The Hamburg Workshop will help gain an understanding of the issues faced by RI Operators and public funding organisations with respect to the different funding schemes and aims to **deliver recommendations** to improve RI funding in the next **generation of structural funds** and **EU Framework Programme**. The two-day event will follow an interactive approach, where participants will be encouraged to share in-depth information.
