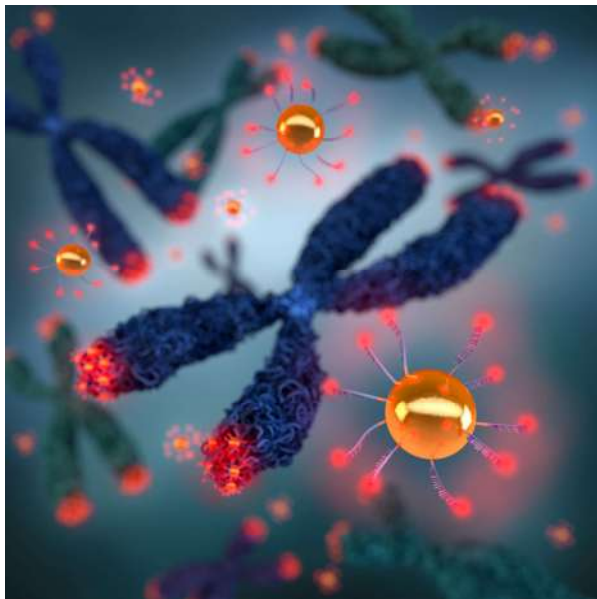

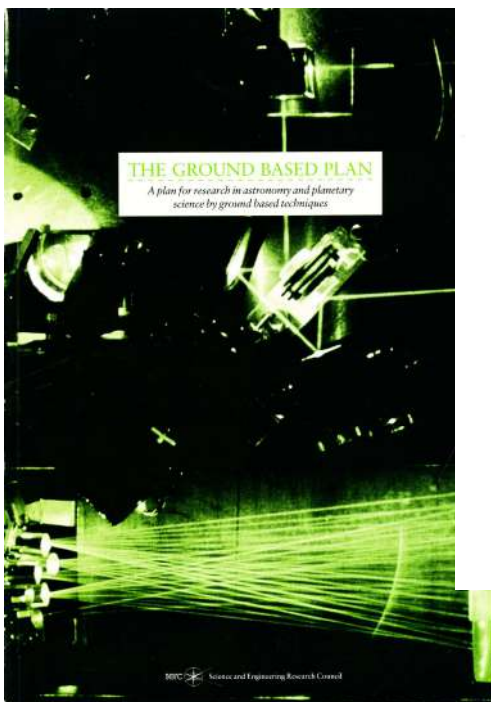

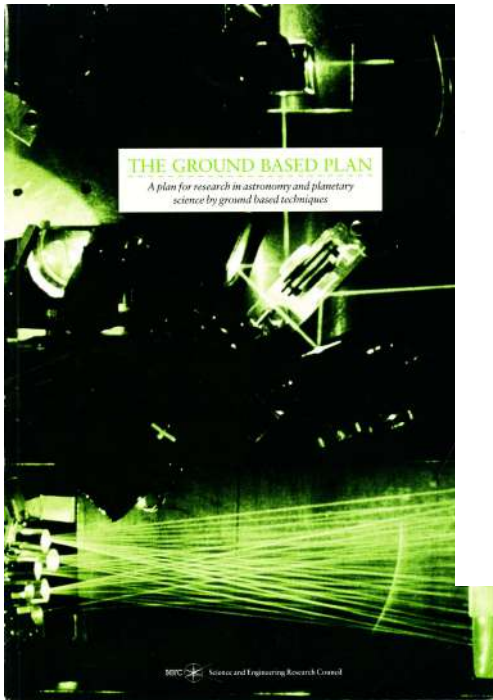
## Development of the Plan: the key projects

### E15 The four key projects are:

- i. MERLIN Phase 2. This has already been approved.
- ii. About 25% of a Polar Cap incoherent scatter radar.
- iii. At least 25% of a gravitational radiation observatory.
- iv. An 8m class optical/infrared telescope package including at least 40% of an 8m class telescope.

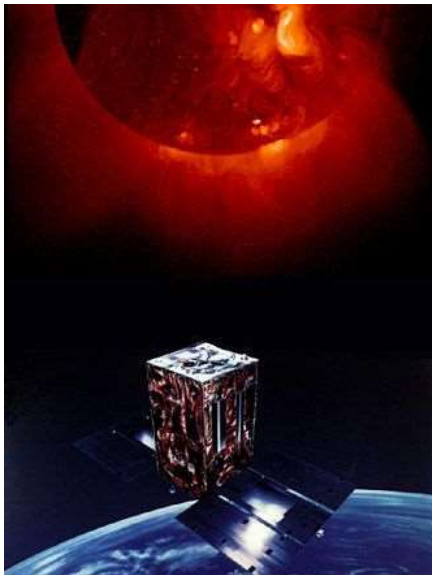

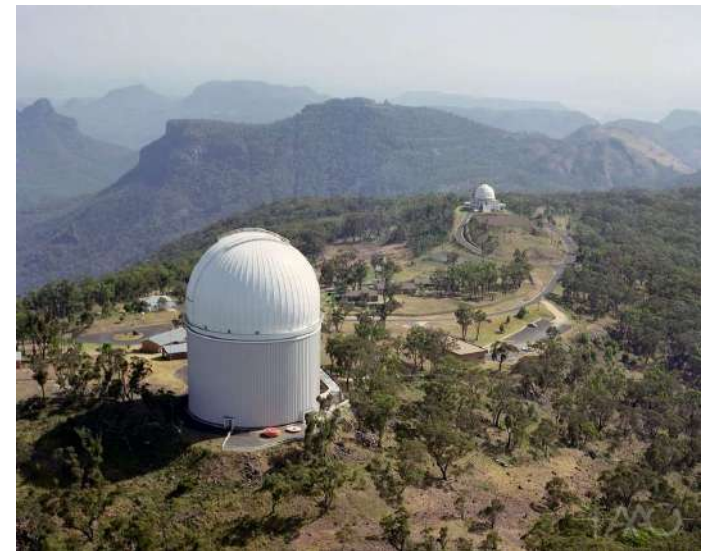
